

## **April Opportunities:**

Experience Your Bible - Wed. Nights @ 6:00 All Church Retreat - April 14<sup>th</sup> after Worship!

We have two key opportunities for our church family coming up in May. The first one I want to talk about here is our **All Church Retreat.** This retreat will be used to show us how we can use the Alpha Course to help our family, friends and neighbors to consider Jesus.



*"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."- Jesus* (Acts 1:8)

#### What is the Alpha Course?

"First developed as a short course in 1977 at Holy Trinity Brompton (HTB) in London, England, Nicky Gumbel began running Alpha in 1990 and repositioned it as a course for those outside of the church after finding that many individuals wanted to explore the Christian faith. The number of people attending Alpha at HTB quickly grew to the hundreds and as a result, caught the attention of other churches seeking to find an effective tool for evangelism.

Alpha USA launched in the 1990s in response to how the Holy Spirit was using the courses as an evangelization tool for American churches. Alpha USA exists to serve and support churches in making disciples of Jesus Christ, as Christians play their part in the reevangelization of the nations and the transformation of society. It runs in more than 8,000 churches and ministries across every major denomination and 600 prisons throughout the country. Alpha mobilizes over 50,000 volunteers and over 500,000 participants annually in the USA and more than 1.3 million globally."

So I'm looking forward to our church family getting a chance to consider ways we can help our community re-consider Jesus through the Alpha Course.

The other opportunity, coming up in April, is a laid-back discussion group centered around helpful ways we can each get more out of God's Word, on Wednesday nights.

We'll work through the book, *Experience Your Bible*, which will give us fresh ways to dig deeper into God's revelation to us. Sessions will be led by men who are "World Famous in Fairfield!"


