

Fall Group Study Beginning Wed. Oct. 2nd

But now, thus says the Lord, your Creator, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine! (Isaiah 43:1)

The very first episode of *The Chosen* TV series opens with this verse from Isaiah, quoting God the Father, "I have called you by name; you are mine!" This opening sets the theme and the tone of the whole series. What an awesome truth! God calls people to Himself!

But you might have noticed that in this verse God, the Creator, is specifically speaking to Israel. We know that the Bible refers to the Jewish people as "God's chosen people", and this brings up several questions. In what sense is the nation of Israel chosen? Is anyone else "chosen"? Who, exactly, does God call? How can someone know if God has chosen them?

These are the kinds of questions that we'll discuss in this season's Group Bible Study. While the study will use the episodes from Season 1 of *The Chosen* TV series, the focus of the study, published by David C. Cook, is on Isaiah 43. The introduction describes it this way:

"This is the official companion study to season 1 of The Chosen, the groundbreaking television series about the life of Jesus. What Does It Mean to Be Chosen? parallels each episode, connecting readers to the Bible in a brand-new way. It includes:

- A deeper look at Isaiah 43 and its fulfillment in Jesus and the lives of His followers (including us!)
- Script excerpts, quotes, and illustrations from the show.
- Guiding questions for groups or individuals.

Being chosen by Jesus has beautiful and far-reaching implications—although it says even more about the Chooser than the choosees. We are loved because He is love. We are saved because He is merciful. We belong to the family of God because Jesus invites us, making the Bible and all its promises as true for us today as it was for God's chosen people.

What does it actually mean to be Chosen? To answer that question, we're going Old school–Testament that is–which leads us back to the New. Which always leads us directly to Jesus."

I hope you'll join in for our discussions on Wednesday nights, beginning at 6:00. Better yet, come early and enjoy our Wednesday Night Church Family Meal at 5:30 and stay for the discussion!
